1. Attend and complete SAR Basic Certification as required by the Ontario Search and Rescue Volunteer Association under a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ontario Provincial Police.
2. Participate as a searcher in a search exercise (SAREX). Searchers must arrive fully prepared and equipped for the search, weather and search area conditions.
3. Attend and become proficient in these four areas:
 - Compass and Navigation
 - GPS
 - Clues and Evidence
 - SAR Medical
4. Contribute on a regular basis to Unit activities (monthly meetings, fund raising, and public relation events)

OPP criminal reference check (CRC) /Complete ICS-100 EXAM & acquire the certificate

For new applicants, membership is probationary for the first year.

Full membership is at the discretion of the Board of Directors of LSRU
